## Part B. CV SUMMARY

Francisca Pérez Carreño is Professor of Aesthetics and Art Theory at the University of Murcia and Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy. She was President of the European Society for Aesthetics (2015-2022) and a member of its Executive Committee (2008-2012). She was also a member of the Executive Committee of the Sociedad Española de Estética y Teoría de las Artes (2011-2018).

She works mainly in the field of philosophical aesthetics and the theory of contemporary art. She has published a monograph on the philosophy of the image (*Los placeres del parecido. Icono y representación*) and several articles on pictorial representation and expression ("Looking at Metaphors", "Two routes to expression in painting", "La Percezione Espressiva della Natura e dell'Arte"). She has written on the philosophy of sculpture ("La escultura. Un arte del espacio", "Teatralidad y la Escultura como un arte") and is the author of the book on Minimal Art: *El arte minimal. Objeto y sentido*. She has written articles on the philosophy of contemporary art, such as "Significado y acción. Notas sobre Arte Conceptual en España", "Memoria, arte contemporáneo e identidad: Ilya Kabákov", "Experiencia y teoría estética en el arte conceptual". She has also published extensively on women painters and feminist art history: "Naturaleza y sujeto en Georgia O'Keefe", "Drama y espectador en Artemisia Gentileschi", "Estrategias conceptuales del arte feminista" and a book on Artemisia Gentileschi. She has also worked on the history of aesthetics, editing the formalist art theorists Konrad Fiedler (Escritos sobre arte) and Adolf von Hildebrand (*El problema de la forma en la obra de arte*).

In recent decades her research has focused on the rationality of aesthetic experience, perception and judgment, and on the relationship of aesthetic value and other values in art. She has published on the normativity of expressive perception and the aesthetic experience of the everyday ("Theatricality and Everyday Aesthetics", "Aesthetic Normativity and the Expressive Perception of Nature", "The aesthetic value of the unnoticed", and the value of the aesthetic in "*El valor moral del arte y la emoción*", "*Sentimentality as an Ethical and Aesthetic Fault*", and "*El sentimentalismo como falta de sinceridad*".)

She is the author of numerous articles on contemporary philosophical aesthetics, including: "Estetización y autonomía estratégica", "Institución-arte e intencionalidad artística", "El artista como reportero. Los mitos del fotoperiodismo artístico", and "La concepción de la imagen en el arte contemporáneo". She has been Keynote Speaker in a number of international conferences and seminars.

Pérez Carreño is the editor or co-editor of the following collections: En torno al arte. Estética. historia y crítica (2023), El valor del arte (2017), Estética después del fin del arte. Ensayos sobre A. Danto (2005), Expression in the Performing Arts (2010), Significado, emoción y valor. Ensayos sobre Filosofía de la Música (2012) y Estética (2013).

She has been Visiting Scholar at the University of Berkeley, University of Cambridge, and the Pompeu Fabra University.

The group is funded by the Spanish Government and the Government of the Autonomous Region of Murcia. She has been PI of 7 Research Projects. She has organized and participated in several conferences and scientific meetings and has contributed greatly to the internationalization of the Spanish Aesthetics.

She has 6 periods of research activity recognized by the Spanish CNEAI.
