Part B. Brief summary of CV

Graduate (1994) and Doctor in Psychology from the University of Seville (2001), he has been a tenured professor in the Department of Developmental and Educational Psychology since 2009. He began his research career linked to the first R+D+i project financed in Spain about bullying, where he carried out his doctoral thesis under the direction of Professor Ortega in the Laboratory for Studies on Coexistence and Prevention of Violence, with whom he has been linked until 2016, at which time he went on to constitute an autonomous research group: Interpersonal Aggression and Socio-Emotional Development (SEJ580). Its main lines of research are on school bullying and cyber-bullying, particularly interested in coping strategies and the analysis of the metacognitive processes involved. He has systematically participated in competitive research projects of an international, national and regional nature, as a result of which he has produced international scientific output with internationally renowned researchers, highlighting his work with Prof. Peter Smith, with whom he carried out a post-doctoral stay.

For the last ten years he has shown his leadership and training capacity. Specifically, in 2011, he was awarded a research project of excellence by the Junta de Andalucía, in which he led



the research team. He is already PI of a research project funded by the National Research Agency focus on bystanders' responses against cyberviolence. Subsequently, and to date, he has been the principal researcher of three European projects and has been a Spanish member of the Management Committee Members of two COST actions: IS0801 "Cyberbullying: coping with negative and enhancing positive uses of new technologies, in relationships in educational settings" and CA15221 "Advancing effective institutional models towards cohesive teaching, learning, research and writing development". As a result of this trajectory, it has been selected by the EU to co-lead the advice to the Slovenian government in the reform it is developing to prevent violence among minors. To date he has directed two doctoral theses and is currently directing three more.

Since 2010 he has been an evaluator for ANEP and is a member of the panel of evaluators of the European Research Council. He is a reviewer of internationally recognized journals such as the British Journal of Educational Psychology, Computer in Human Behavior, Cyberpsychology, Behavior, and Social Networking and is a member of the editorial committee of the journal "Psychology, Society and Education". He has also participated as an evaluator and external consultant in European projects (within the DAPHNE call) and as an external expert in a project of the Portuguese National Research Plan call (PTDC/MHCPED/3297/2014, IP Ana Margarida Simao). He is also part of one of the thematic groups of the Student Well-being and Prevention of Violence Research group of the University of Flinders (Australia).
