Part B. CV SUMMARY (*max. 5000 characters, including spaces*)

Since his student years, García Rivero has been aware of the importance of the Philosophy of Science in the Humanities. This has led him to seek out a wide range of training opportunities and stays with professors from different universities and countries (Southampton, 2003; London, 2008, 2010, 2011; Columbia, USA, 2012; Buenos Aires, 2013; Faro, 2014; Köln, 2021). In the last decade, he has been successful in consolidating the archaeological understanding of the theory of evolution and the principles of cultural transmission both at the theoretical level (e.g. *Complutum* 2012; Ed. Universidad Sevilla 2010, 2013; Springer 2016), with contributions aimed at generating critical knowledge not only among specialists, but also among students, and the methodological level (e.g. *Plos One* 2014, 2021; *Archaeo Anthropol Sci* 2016; *J Archaeol Sci* 2017; *JAS, Reports* 2019; *J Field Archaeol* 2022), with relevant contributions on sequencing techniques and methods in the evolution cultural arena. In recognition, he has received invitations to teach seminars and give lectures at universities in different countries (e.g. Cuernavaca, Mexico 2014; Mexico DF 2015; Barcelona 2016; Coimbra 2017; Algarve 2017; Valencia 2018; Köln 2022) and to form part of several international scientific committees (e.g. Arizona 2015; Faro 2017; Cancún 2017; Seville 2020). In addition, García Rivero has contributed to the knowledge of diverse periods and phenomena, especially in Late Prehistory: the Mesolithic-Neolithic transition in Central Portugal (*Quat Internat* 2017; *Europ J of Archaeol* 2020); the origin of farming and herding populations in Southern Iberia (Munibe 2018; *Quat Sci Rev* 2019, *Plos One* 2020, 2021; *Spal* 2021; *J Field Archaeol* 2022) and their dispersal across Western Mediterranean (*JAS, Reports* 2019; *Documenta Praehist* 2021); the evolution of symbolic representations in the Late Neolithic and Copper Age in Iberia (*Plos One* 2014, *Estudios Arqueol Oeiras* 2015; *Archaeo Anthropol Sci* 2016); the Bell Beaker in SW (British *Archaeol Reports* 2008, *J Archaeol Sci* 2016); the Copper-Bronze Age transition in SW Iberia (*Zephyrus* 2015); etc. In addition to his permanent position at the University of Seville, García Rivero is an Associated Researcher in two international research centres: International Centre for Archaeology and Evolution of Human Behaviour and Research Centre for Anthropology and Health, and maintains close collaborations with several universities in the UK, USA, Argentina, Mexico, Germany and Portugal. He has taken on a relevant role in



terms of scientific responsibilities, including membership in international (2) and national (2) research projects; international scientific committees (4); organisation of international (2) and national (5) congresses; editorial and journal committees (4); juries for academic awards (1); academic commissions through elected officials (1); editions of conference proceedings (3); and numerous evaluations of academic works, research articles for scientific journals, applications for research projects for the State Research Agency. His leadership role has increased through his position as PI in the Project Cueva de la Dehesilla, of the Junta de Andalucía (2015-present); in a R+D+i of the Call for Excellence 2018; in the implementation of the FACTUS Project (2017-present), a solid teaching commitment of the Vice-Rectorate for Teaching and the Faculty of Geography and History of the University of Seville; in projects of private entities, such as the PALARQ Foundation; as well as in collaboration contracts for junior staff, research initiation and research management (Ministry of Education, University of Seville, Regional Government of Andalusia/ERDF, respectively). The funding received, added to other internal grants from the University of Seville, as well as from other sources (e.g. University of Coimbra), exceeds 165,000 euros. All these activities generate a substantial contribution to society and to the training of young researchers, an essential commitment of Dr. García Rivero as a lecturer and an active researcher. Indeed, he is currently also the Coordinator of the Archaeology Degree of the University of Seville.
