1. GENERAL

Visiting professor at several universities in Europe and America. Senior fellow at the Law School (Boalt Hall), UC Berkeley (USA), visiting researcher at the Max Planck Institut für europäische Rechtsgeschichte. National end-of-degree prize (1978), prize of the Real Maestranza de Sevilla (1977). Fullright Fellow (1987), Research Grants from the German Academic Exchange Service (1979-1980), Max Planck Society (1982, 1988, 2000, 2001), French Ministry of Science (1982), and Austrian Ministry of Science and Research (1979).



Evaluator of the Consiglio Nazionale per la Ricerca (Italy), referee for projects of the competent Spanish Ministry and for journals in his speciality. Real Maestranza Prize for the best academic record (1977), Graduate National Prize (1978), Galileo Galilei Prize (Rotary Club of Italy - University of Pisa), 58th edition (2019).

2. CURRENT LINES OF RESEARCH

--The codification of law: history and comparison. After a long journey in this direction, the monograph *Otros códigos* (2023), with an analysis of several foreign codes in the Spanish legal culture, stands out recently. This is an original approach 'from outside' that has also been presented in postgraduate courses (2005-2018) at the University of Medellín (Colombia) and the Federal University of Paraná (Curitiba, Brazil).

--History of the comparative law tradition as a discipline and international networks of jurists. This is a project with several advances; on Édouard Lambert, on his school in Lyon, on the Congress of comparative law of 1900. This led to a study of the scientific relations between Europeans and North Americans: from the case of Gény in North America (1991), to the tradition of European romanists in the United States and Max Radin (2001). He also discussed reception and translations of criminologists in John H. Wigmore's Modern Criminal Law Science series (2007). He recently published an essay on the late Lambert in the 50th volume of the prestigious Quaderni fiorentini, dedicated to "Pluralismo giuridico".

--History of legal-mercantile institutions and commercial law. It has recently resulted in a comprehensive work (*Historia del Derecho mercantil*, 2016) and a monograph (*Imagen y concepto de los títulos valores en la España ilustrada*, 2017), both published by Marcial Pons. The contributions continue with several works on commercial law in the 20th century.

--History of legal disciplines. Of particular note is the *Diccionario de catedráticos españoles de Derecho, 1847-1984* (<https://humanidadesdigitales.uc3m.es/s/catedraticos/page/inicio>). With more than 950 biographies and a complete target of more than a thousand, it registers more than 50,000 entries per year; within its framework Elizabeth Martínez wrote her thesis on exiled professors in Mexico (2016), and Fernando Liendo on the legal education and legal journals (2020).
